I took charge of the First Team this year with keen enthusiasm and high expectations, and why not! It is an honour in any Club to manage the best eleven players and I certainly enjoyed every moment.

My ultimate thanks have to go to every one of the players who put on a First Team shirt, whether it was for full games or part games. They were asked to go out and perform week in week out and that has to take commitment.

It started way back in June at Bisham Abbey. No silverware this season and equalling 94-95 Season, fifth spot in Division 2. I am a little disappointed we didn't get promotion this year because at times we matched the best. Why didn't we finish higher? Because we were not consistent enough in 22 League games. We took teams apart at times with glorious football and at other times we looked very ordinary, lacking that vital 'will to win' fever.

The Club has tried manfully this season to carry the success of last season's Under 17 team (who were joint Champions of the Beds.Colts League) into this season's Chiltern Youth League at Under Eighteen.

In pre-season training we hoped that the core of last season's team would mix with new players from the village to produce a strong new side, although the defection to Ramridge of last season's top scorer John King did not help the cause. Mick Justin and I tried hard to get the players together, but the policy of training with the adults was by and large unsuccessful and we realised we had a lot of work to do when a pre-season friendly against a strong Toddington side brought a 10-0 thrashing.

Worse was to follow - for our first League outing to Bedford both first choice goalkeepers were unavailable and Steve Lomas and Kev McGovern both had a go at closing the floodgates in an 11-0 defeat. Morale was at rock bottom and it was no surprise when the first home game against an ordinary Lewsey side brought another heavy defeat. This was the end of our Division 1 campaign as we successfully applied to the League to be demoted to Division 2.

For a while it looked as though we would be successful. We outplayed the Japanese from Gyosei, with Sean Fahy outstanding, before tiring and conceding a late equaliser. The following week, however, showed that some players find 3 games a weekend too much and a tired second-half saw us lose 5-1 to Barton Rovers.

The County Cup brought some welcome relief, with a last-minute winner in a replay vs. St.Mary's and a good fighting performance before going down 6-3 to Ramridge. We couldn't reproduce this form in the League, however, and a team depleted by injuries and absence lost a poor match 4-1 at St.Marys.

By this stage, time was becoming a problem for me and our adverts for a new manager had brought a response from Steve Line, who had held a similar position with Harpenden Town last year. His first game started well enough, with the team leading against Milton Keynes Rangers, before eventually tiring again and losing 6-2.

A nightmare trip in the December fog to eventual runaway winners Stevenage Borough followed, with taxis being needed to get the team there after a breakdown. A 7-1 thrashing was followed by Steve's absence through illness for the Sundon Park game. An opportunity to pick up points was lost through a lack of communication and instead we ended up with a fine for not fulfilling the fixture. Two more close defeats were followed by two WINS! 4-1 defeats of Ramridge Maroons and St.Mary's, where blatant cheating by the St.Mary's manager (who was refereeing at the time) nearly caused a riot!

After this, the season fizzled out with five more defeats. A fine performance in a narrow 1-0 defeat vs. Barton being eclipsed by the final 6-0 hammering by Stevenage.

Steve Line's time as manager ended with another non-appearance, this time vs. Milton Keynes when again we failed to get a team together in time. I have heard nothing from Steve since.

My overriding impression is of what might have been. With a full side playing to its potential we could hold our own with most teams in the division, but we under-performed in too many games. I feel sorry for the players who showed potential and commitment and I hope they will join the Club next season to play in the adult sides.
