President's Report

The end of another season at Pirton – just! As some of you will know the committee of the Pirton Sports and Social Club (PSSC) spent a good deal of time last year deciding how much Lea Sports should be charged for use of the pitches at the Rec. Or at least, a two-man sub-committee did. Just for the record, the sequence of events was as follows: at a management meeting of the PSSC, which I attended, before Christmas 2002 the sub-committee was charged with negotiating with Lea Sports with a view to reaching a financial agreement by February 2003. By April 2003, Lea Sports had still not been approached by this sub-committee, so we put forward our own proposals for what we considered to be a reasonable increase. We calculated what the fees would be if an increase in line with inflation had been applied since our move to Pirton and presented these to the PSSC. They rejected these proposals, being of the opinion that it costs the PSSC money for Lea Sports to play there and that we should be charged with half of the total costs of electricity and cleaning of the premises.

Time rolled on towards the new season without an agreement, until in the Summer of 2003 we were presented with two figures: one represented an 80% increase in our fees and the second was almost two and a half times what we were paying, but they would mark the pitches in that price! In the end the only concession made was that the lower figure (which was 'not negotiable') would include our club subscriptions – this still represented an increase of over 50% in our pitch fees. Some Lea Sports committee members were of the opinion that we should up sticks and move back to Luton and it was touch and go for a while as to which way things would go. In the end, the deciding factor was probably a hefty donation from our sponsors Premier Computer Supplies towards the increase in fees. Premier's owner, Hugh Byrne, recognised that there were people in Pirton who obviously thought that the increase in fees would force the Club out of the village, but we were determined not to give them the satisfaction.

We now have a five-year agreement in place, which confirms our commitment to the village and prevents us being walloped with a similar draconian increase in our costs. With the agreement in place, we hoped that there would be a fresh impetus to improve the changing facilities at the club. I myself offered to take on the 'poison chalice' of the PSSC Chairmanship, but it was made abundantly clear to me that there was still a good deal of personal opposition to that proposal! At the time of writing, that position has still not been filled and the PSSC is desperately trying to stimulate interest in the village for the facilities at the Rec.

In the meantime, we just get on with our football. I am very pleased to announce that next year will see a new Under Elevens team, made up predominantly of boys from the village. In recognition of this, and of our commitment to the village, a proposal was being put forward to the AGM for a change of name for the Club. That AGM is scheduled for May 19th, so depending on whether you are reading this at the Youth teams' Presentation Evening or the Adults' Presentaion Evening, the decision is imminent, or has already been made. Last year I think it would have been academic as to whether a name change would have been accepted, but with all the nonsense with pitch fees, the decision is now much less clear. A lot of ill-feeling was created by the way this Club was treated and it may take some time for that to subside.

If you are an adult player reading this, I hope you bothered to go along to the AGM and that you voted on the proposals put forward, one of which was another increase in club subscriptions to help meet this year's costs. If you didn't go to the AGM, or if you went and didn't vote, please don't complain at changes in the Constitution or increases in costs. If it was up to us, we'd love to pay all of you for playing for Lea Sports, but life's not like that and we do the very best that we can to make sure that the Club has a secure future, with well-equipped and well-run teams playing on well-prepared pitches with good off-the-field facilities. If you think you can do better – come and join the Committee.

Given all the uncertainty, I think it's a credit to all the teams that they managed to do as well as they did. The managers will all give their reports in this magazine, but all of the teams gave good accounts of themselves, with the Under Thirteens in particular being very unlucky not to bring another Championship Trophy to the silverware cabinet.

One notable achievement this season is Archie Conway reaching 500 appearances for the Club. Some 1,092 players have now appeared for the Club in its 31-year history, but only four of those have made over 500 appearances, so Archie joins an exclusive Club with Kelvin Callow, Rick Vipers and Phil Clarke. I hope that Phil Thompson will also make that milestone next season – Phil keeps making the headlines himself: this season he scored his 300th First Team goal (in a total of 525) and made his 300th First Team appearance. Richard Knock was the latest player to come from the youth teams into the First Team. Richard played in Godfrey Knock's successful under-16 team and has now made over 160 appearances for the Club, since his début in 1997 at under-11.

I was very proud that the Club was able to make a donation of £150 to the Disney Ward at the Northampton General Hospital, most of which was collected from the players. This was in memory of Alan Dawson's daughter Charlotte who died at the age of 12 after a long fight against a brain tumour. Of course nothing can remove the pain of losing a child, but I hope the donation will be seen as a mark of respect from the Club to one of its longest-serving players.

Thanks to all those who took part in this season's Premier League Competition. The competition will be running again next year (go on, I dare you not to put Norwich bottom!) so please do have a go – it all helps the funds in the coffers.

It was also nice to see the resurrection of the Premier Computer Supplies Invitation Cup last summer, even if we did finish last. This is a good way of providing us with some pre-season matches as well as bringing in some revenue. I think I chose our opposition well last year: Macdonald Humfrey were leading the Luton & District Premier before pulling out and Ewe & Lamb will finish as Division One Champions!

Hopefully, we can arrange some other events in the summer, five-a-sides and the like. Please support the Club all you can and have a great season next year.

First Team Report

Ten Years Ago – Season 1993-1994

Lea Sports Stopsley FC played their penultimate season on the notorious pitches at Stopsley Sports Centre in Luton. We were running four Sunday teams, plus a Saturday side for the first time and youth teams at Under 16 and Under 14.

The first and second teams' records are almost identical to this season's. The First Team finished 4th in Division 2, winning 11 and drawing 2 of their 20 games. Phil Thompson was top scorer with 37 goals and manager Kev Boxall selected Gavin Campbell as his player of the season. Gav also won the players' vote. Of today's players only Andy Shiers was a first team regular, along with Russ Sheppard, Alan Dawson, Graham Hunt, Alex Houghton and the other Mark Williams!

The Reserves finished 4th in Division 5 (sound familiar?) winning 13 and drawing 3 of their 22 league games. Laurence Freed took charge of the fourths and they finished 7th in the Luton Sunday division 2. Highlight of the season was the appearance in the Luther Blissett cup final at St.Albans. Just before the final, top scorer Sandy Muir went walkabout and we eventually lost 1-0 to Hightown. A good night was had by all, however, and we have the fire extinguishers to prove it.
