# President's Report

This was a season of some real highs and lows: let's get the lows out of the way first!

Firstly, the horrible break to Steve Williams' leg in the match vs. Britannia on 31<sup>st</sup> October. Steve knew immediately that the leg was broken and was remarkably composed during the wait for the ambulance and the transfer to the Lister Hospital. It is a great credit to him that he made no fuss or recriminations, but just accepted the damage that had been done with his usual reserve. Months of recuperation followed, with Steve unable to work, but our appeal to the Benevolent Fund of the Hertfordshire FA for a grant for Steve was met with a flat refusal. In my view, that was a disgraceful action on the part of the County FA and I think the members of that Committee should hang their heads in shame. What is the fund for if not for players who suffer financial loss through an injury on the field?

Secondly, the news that Baggy could not be persuaded to change his mind from retiring at the end of this season. Steve has achieved some remarkable successes for this Club and has contributed in many more ways off the pitch. He will be sorely missed and I hope that after a season of kicking his heels, he'll realise that Lea Sports needs him more than his settee does. It was going to be even worse with the news that Bob Smith was leaving as well, but Bob's seen the light and pledged his services for another year (so I'll save his eulogy until then).

The main highs were, of course, the performances of the Under 11s. Not only did they sweep all before them in the League, but they battled through five away ties in the County Cup to reach the Semi-Final against Letchworth Garden City Eagles. This was always going to be a tough game (Letchworth do, after all, run 33 youth teams!) but it was made more difficult by a home pitch cut up by over-use by the casuals in particular. Despite scoring early, we went 2-1 down and it needed a late equaliser to take the tie into extra time. This proved too much for the lads and they eventually went down 4-2, but they did provide great entertainment on the way and have brought much pride and kudos to the Club by their efforts.

The Reserves too kept their season alive until the final week, when they could have snatched the title if results had gone our way. In the end their third place should be enough for promotion and I'm sure they'll be more than equal to the challenges of Division 4.

The Club is increasingly finding its identity and these successes (plus events like the joint Awards Evening) serve only to consolidate that. We hope that next season we will have even further representation at youth level, with potential seven-a-side teams at Under 11, Under 10 and even Under 9. This will ensure that the Club has a buoyant and vibrant future and I greatly look forward to it. The Committee has also taken the decision that in future all new kits will be red and black stripes, further emphasising the Club identity. The future of Lea Sports Pirton F.C. certainly does look bright.

## **Phil Thompson**

On Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2004, Phil Thompson made his 500<sup>th</sup> appearance for Lea Sports in a first XI win over Limbury Black Swan. He also scored his 529<sup>th</sup> goal for the Club, which is a little ironic as it was against the same opposition that Phil scored his 500<sup>th</sup> goal on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2003.

Phil's debut was on 21<sup>st</sup> November 1982, when as a skinny 17-year-old he scored in the Third Team's 2-2 draw with Toddington Farmers. He soon progressed to the Reserves where he scored another 4 goals that season, plus a further 3 for the First Team. Illness in the mid-eighties prevented Phil from holding a regular place in the team, but by the late eighties he was reaching his peak form and scored 38 goals in 27 games in 1988-89.

In the early nineties, Phil was lured away from Lea Sports by the prospect of playing for Ashcroft in the South Midlands league, but in 1993-94 he was back with a vengeance, scoring 42 goals in 28 games as Lea Sports finished fourth in Division 2 of the North Home Counties. Phil scored in 10 consecutive games that season and scored 4 times on 3 occasions, plus another 3 hat-tricks.

His record scoring performance came on 6<sup>th</sup> November 1988 in a Division 3 match vs. Holy Ghost. I remember that Guru Nanak had beaten Holy Ghost 16-0 a few weeks earlier and when we were 9-0 up at half-time, I set the team the target of beating that total. Phil scored seven that day at Leagrave Park, but he hit the bar twice and the post as we ran out winners by 17-0. Incidentally, Alan Dawson scored 4 that day and actually finished top scorer for the first team that season with 29 goals from 22 games, whereas Phil 'only' managed 24 first team goals. Funnily enough, a few weeks later on 18<sup>th</sup> December, Phil scored his 100<sup>th</sup> Lea Sports goal in the return fixture with Holy Ghost, which we won by a more modest 7-1.

By the late nineties, it looked as though Phil's first team days were over and Steve Baggett was happy to play him in his Third Team, which was playing in the Luton Sunday League. Phil was far too good for this level of football and in 1998-99 he scored 45 goals for the thirds, plus another 10 for the Reserves, to give him 55 goals from just 32 games. In 7 games between 1<sup>st</sup> November and 1<sup>st</sup> January that season, he scored 28 goals, including 2 double hat-tricks. That was the year that the thirds won the Challenge Cup, with a 4-0 victory in the final – Phil failed to score that day!

In 2000-2001, when rain ruined the season, Baggie persuaded Phil to come back to the First Team and he hit 25 goals in a season mainly lost to the weather. Another two seasons followed with over 30 goals in each and there seems to be no end to the exploits of the goalscoring phenomenon that is Phil Thompson.

I have been privileged to see probably hundreds of the games Phil has scored in, and I have seen few finer players in local football. Over the years of writing these booklets I have probably run out of superlatives to describe Phil's record, so I will just end by saying 'Phil Thompson – Simply the Best'.

You have all done me proud and the club has always been your first thought.*

*I can honestly say that I'm proud to have been manager of the teams over the years. ## Ten Years Ago – Season 1994-95

The Club played its last season as Lea Sports Stopsley FC and its last season on the notorious pitches at Stopsley Regional Sports Centre. A deal had been done with Pirton Sports and Social Club for the teams to play at the Recreation Ground in Pirton from 1995-6 onwards.

Keith Lee took over as Chairman and on the field the Club enjoyed its best-ever season. Overall, we played a total of 233 matches, of which we won 139, scoring 768 goals in the process. The Second Team achieved an 80% success rate and the Fourth Team 84.5%, giving us a stunning overall record.

In fact, the adult sides won 101 of their 160 matches, scoring 513 goals and conceding 282 – an overall success rate of 70%, which is fantastic. Even the Vets had a good season, winning most of their 10 matches.

The Fourth Team finished as Champions of the Luton Sunday League Division 2, 12 points ahead of rivals Luton Rangers. They clinched the title with three games to go after a 5-1 win over Hibbert Arms.

The Under Seventeens' season, under Kieran Dimambro, stretched on until well into May as the Club disputed a two-point penalty for an unplayed match vs. Sandy Albion. In the end we won our fight with the League at a Beds FA Hearing and the restored two points gave us a share of the title in a four-way split with Bletchley Colts, Brickhill Wanderers and Kempston Colts.

The Under 15's under Dave O'Dell also had a 70% record and only a slip-up in their last few matches prevented them from winning the title. They scored 116 goals (of which Robert O'Dell scored 45) which was far more than anyone else in the Division.

Best of all, though, were the Reserves under Laurence Freed. They won 16, drew 1 and lost just 3 of their 20 league games and won Division 5 by 4 points from Houghton Town Reserves. They reached the semi-final of the Luton News Cup, losing in the end by a solitary goal to Britannia Airways. The Beds Centenary Cup brought even more success and a Cup Final appearance at Cranfield on St. George's Day 1995.

A lot of the players were also playing in the Saturday team, who finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Luton & District Division 1 behind Harveys and Monarch Aircraft. By the time the Cup Final came round, we had such a fixture backlog that we were expected to play on every evening except Friday before the Final! In the end all these games took their toll and the Final itself was a bit of a struggle. Nevertheless we drew 0-0 with the Rising Sun from Potton after extra time and the game went first to penalties, then to sudden death penalties. The end came when Alex Houghton, probably one of the best players in the squad, stepped up and put his kick over the bar. We had lost, but without disgrace and we all had a good drink afterwards.

It was the end of a great season; one in which it was a real surprise to hear of a Lea Sports defeat – for any of the teams. There we were, moving to superb new pitches at Pirton, surely things could only continue to get better.....

## Twenty Five Years Ago – Season 1979-80

1979-80 saw Ivan Lawrence relinquish the rôle of First Team Manager, which he had held since the Club's formation in 1973. The job of getting the team out of Division 4 was taken on by Elwyn 'Sid' Owen and Keith Lee. In the previous season the team had finished seventh, but it was hoped that new striker Ray Taylor and the improving form of Steve Castleman alongside the prolific Phil Clarke would provide the goals, while Paul Lawrence had taken over from his dad in goal and was to miss only one game all season.

The hoped-for improvement did not materialise, however, and the team took just one point from its first six league games (from a 1-1 draw at home to Wells Stars in the very first game). Ray Taylor's temper proved too hot for the Club and it was not until mid-October that Dave Blake claimed a regular first-team place.

The first team's involvement in the County Cup was short-lived - after a rare trip to Hitchin to defeat Motorola 6-0 in the First round, the team entertained the Bedford Italians Campani in Round Two and lost a tight game 3-2, with Dave Blake scoring his first of the season and Phil Clarke notching the other. A bye in the First Round of the Luton News Cup was followed by a good 1-0 away win at Caddington Reserves, with Steve Castleman on target.

With the early traumas out of the way, the team settled down to a better run of form, with only one defeat in the nine games before the Luton News Quarter-Final in Leighton Buzzard against Linslade Youth Club. Hopes were high that a Semi-Final place might be in the offing, but goals from Steve Castleman and Dave Pymont were not enough and the team went down 3-2.

This result seemed to affect the team's confidence and a draw against Nesco was followed by a 5-0 home thumping by eventual Champions AFC Wheels. Linslade were the next League visitors and they completed a hat-trick of wins with another 3-2 scoreline.

The season ended with the team in poor spirits and only a 4-0 win against bottom club Greenleys produced any points from the last five games. The team finished in eighth spot with 19 points from 24 matches. Dave Pymont topped the scoring chart with 15 goals, followed by Steve Castleman on 12 and Dave Blake on 10.

The Reserves had finished fourth in Division 7 in the previous season and with Ivan Lawrence taking over as Second Team Manager optimism was high in the run-up to the new decade. This optimism appeared well-founded after the first five matches, when three wins and two draws were recorded. Ali Hearn was in top form, scoring in four of the five games.

October, however, saw the team's form collapse - the next nine games brought only two points (funnily enough from two 3-3 draws against Valley Sports) and included a 6-2 home thrashing by eventual Champions AFC Wheels Reserves. Some pride was restored in the last two games of the Seventies with a 2-0 win over Mitre (with goals from Martin McGrath and Wojtek Gabrys) and a 1-1 draw away to Index R.R., with Steve Lacey on target.

It seemed as though the New Year would bring no better fortune when a visit to AC Delco resulted in a 5-1 defeat, but Phil Clarke's appearance in the team reaped benefits and he scored six in three games as the team beat Globe Sports 3-2, Nags Head 5-4 and drew with Royal Oak Reserves 5-5.

A brave effort against AFC Wheels at Leagrave Park followed, with the team losing to a single goal, but Clarke hit six more in the last five games (including all four in a 4-4 draw at Balmforth Engineering) as the team took 7 points from a possible 10 to restore some respectability. Two points lost to an administrative error cost the team four places in the League and they finished in 10th place (out of 14), scoring 63 goals and conceding 66. Champions AFC Wheels Reserves bagged 110 goals, but even they were outdone by runners-up Nags Head who hit 135 goals in their 26 games. Despite Phil Clarke's scoring bursts, Wojtek Gabrys top-scored over the season with 16. Bruce Bonfield missed just one start, appearing as substitute in the 3-2 win over Globe Sports.

Steve Moreton took the reins as the Thirds embarked on their first full season of recorded fixtures. The season started on an uncertain note with a 2-2 draw vs. Microwave being followed by defeats at the hands of Ben's XI (4-7, including a John Williams hat-trick), Luton Round Table (1-4) and Herts.Agriculture College (0-2). However, a creditable 4-4 draw against St.Albans Round Table restored some confidence and wins against Ben's XI (2-0) and Ashcroft School (5-3) followed, although this last result was to be reversed later in the season.

The team's best performance came in a 10-3 win over Balmforth Engineering in February 1980, with Barry Ainsworth scoring four times and John Slater twice. John Slater in fact finished as top scorer with seven goals in his seven appearances. The team scored a total of 49 altogether in six wins, six draws and six defeats, with 52 goals conceded. The Manager Steve Moreton set the standard by appearing in every game, with John Scales on 14 being the only other player to make double figures.

# Twenty Years Ago – Season 1984-85

## First Team - North Home Counties Division 5

Steve Smith took over from Dave Lloyd as First Team Manager, after a knee injury had restricted him to just 10 Second Team appearances the previous season.

The team had reached its lowest point, having finished seventh in Division Five in two consecutive seasons. Despite using five different goalkeepers in the first six games, the team made a solid start, winning five and drawing one of their first seven games (including 3 Cup wins). The only defeat was 5-2 away to Renault Dodge Reserves, with new boy Mark Doyle scoring his first goal for the team.

A 1-1 draw at home to Oakley Rangers Reserves in the County Cup meant a replay just north of Bedford. In an excellent performance Mark Doyle scored twice and Ali Hearn powered in a 30-yard drive as the team progressed with a 4-1 scoreline.

Despite high hopes, third round ties in the County and Luton News Cups brought defeat in successive weeks (2-1 to Nags Head and 3-1 at Limbury Old Boys, with Mark Sunman hardly distinguishing himself in goal in place of the injured Bryn Holmes). The team were soon back to winning ways, however, with 5 wins on the trot, including an 8-0 thrashing of Thames United. The team scored 25 goals in these 5 games, with Mark Doyle scoring 6 and Phil Clarke 7 (including 4 vs. Thames United in a 6-1 win in the return fixture).

The goalscoring touch vanished in the next 3 games though, with a 2-0 defeat vs. Renault, a 1-0 defeat vs. G.I.S. and a 5-0 hammering at Valley Sports. After this, Clarke and Doyle found their aim again and the team finished with 20 goals in the last 5 games.

The team finished in fifth spot with 14 wins and 3 draws from 24 games. The tally of 31 points and 70 goals stood them in good stead, however, and a reorganization of the League saw the team promoted to Division Four and the start of its revival.

Mark Doyle finished with 22 goals from 28 appearances, while Phil Clarke scored 13, Alan Dawson 12 and Al Mayman 11 in a final tally of 90 goals in all competitions.

## Second Team - North Home Counties Division 6

Rick Vipers had taken the Team out of the League basement into Division 6, but handed over the reins to Bill Hind for the 1984-85 season.

The first game of the season brought Mark Doyle's debut for the Club and he scored twice as the team drew 3-3 with Dunstable Victoria Reserves (who eventually finished bottom). Mark's scoring talent was missed in the next game as he joined the First Team and the Reserves lost 1-0 to RFS International (who eventually finished top!)

Team changes continued to affect results and for the fourth season running the team exited from the Reserve Cup at the first hurdle, losing 1-0 at home to Lewsey. Phil Clarke came in to the team and scored 9 times in 8 games before regaining his First Team place. Despite these goals, results were inconsistent, with four wins and 14 goals being followed by four games without a win and 17 goals conceded. Dave Pymont continued to score regularly and Chris Marshall recorded the occasional strike, but on the whole goals were hard to come by in Phil Clarke's absence. Phil Thompson appeared in the team for the last four games, but scored just once as the team finished in disappointing fashion with two defeats against Midbank. Twenty-two points from 26 games saw the team finish in 8th place. Chris Marshall top-scored with 11 in 24 games, while Archie Conway and Phil Clarke both scored 9 in a total of 54 for the season.

## Third Team – Friendlies

Third Team 'controllers' Maurice Dawson and John Scales enjoyed a settled squad for most of this season twenty years ago. Dave Pymont rattled in 8 goals in 5 games before his promotion to the Reserves, but his place was taken by goalscoring phenomenon Keith Bannister who scored 22 goals in just 15 games, including 4 in a 10-0 rout of Schweppes in November 1984.

With Jimmy Gahagan a regular in goal and Andy Thompson, Geoff Richardson, Steve Moreton, John Scales, Tony Riley and Brian Langley forming the backbone of the side, the team enjoyed a rewarding season, although a victory over Luton Round Table eluded the team again, with a record of 6 draws and 9 defeats since the last Lea Sports win in March 1980.
